<i>Dangai-jeppeki-ishi</i>	vertical rock expressing a mountain cliff
<i>Enzan-seki</i>	Removed mountain stone
<i>Hanmagara</i>	Flower pattern on Suiseki
<i>Insho gata ishi</i>	rock with the shade of a trunk
<i>Iwato</i>	Rock
<i>Kenseki</i>	uncommon stone
<i>Kikka-seki</i>	viewing stone with a chrysanthemum-pattern
<i>Kuzuya-ishi</i>	Old hut stone, thatched-hut stone
<i>Moniri-ishi</i>	Viewing stone with embedded figure
<i>Nobara-ishi</i>	Viewing stone with embedded rose-pattern
<i>Senseki</i>	searching stones
<i>Shikisai-ishi</i>	Coloured stone
<i>Shimagata-ishi</i>	Stone expressing an island
<i>Shima-ishi</i>	Stone expressing an island
<i>Suiseki</i>	Viewing stones
<i>Sugata-ishi</i>	Stone expressing a figure
<i>Taki-ishi</i>	Stone expressing a waterfall
<i>Tamti-ishi</i>	Lake-shaped stone
<i>Tsuiseki suru</i>	person collecting stones
<i>Yamagata-ishi</i>	Mountain-shaped stone
